## City Islanders remain undefeated in 2007 Season

### *Harrisburg and New Hampshire play to 0-0 tie*

**(Manchester, NH, May 11, 2007)** – The City Islanders tied the New Hampshire Phantoms 0-0 on Friday night keeping their 2007 undefeated record in tact. While the City Islanders suffered through plenty of turnovers in the first half, they were still able to get several quality chances but were unable to find the net.

The Islanders earned a corner kick in the 4<sup>th</sup> minute of play which was taken by David Schofield who sent a ball across to Adam Clay who headed it towards the side netting. Unfortunately for the Isle guys, the New Hampshire keeper got a piece of the ball which hit the post.

A few minutes later, another near miss occurred when Schofield again sent a beautiful cross to Brian Ombiji who pinged a head ball over the keeper and off the cross bar.

Still in the first half, Ombiji worked with Mo Oduor on a nifty give and go that resulted in an Oduor shot that just went wide of the goal.

The Islanders played a bit more organized and with better ball control to begin the second half and within a few minutes Schofield was once again able to send a ball into Adam Clay who maneuvered behind the defense. New Hampshire keeper Brian Levey (8 saves) was able to storm out of his area and clear Clay's shot.

The final two legitimate goal scoring chances occurred about half way through the second half when Mike Lookingland slid a ball onto Brian Ombiji who was in full stride but again his shot was cleared by goalkeeper Levey. The Islanders recovered the loose ball and it made its way to Chris Morman who rocketed a shot on net from about twenty-five yards out which caused Levey some difficulty but he was once again able to gather the rebound.

Islanders keeper, Matt Nelson made 1 save and recorded his third shutout of the season.

The City Islanders have enjoyed their best start in franchise history with a record of 3-0-2. They next take on the Western Mass Pioneers Saturday May 12, 2007 at Lusitano Stadium in Ludlow Massachusetts with kickoff scheduled for 7:30pm.
